

# Elementary (A1-B)

## **Overall course description:**

- 4 Modules.
- 12 lessons in each Module. 5 hours a week. (2 lessons per week)
- 30 hours of study in each Module
- 120 hours of study in all 4 modules

### Learning aims:

- ✓ The course integrates speaking, writing, listening, and reading skills using a "communicative approach." The course aims at helping you communicate successfully with others in real life.
- ✓ Every lesson has a language focus stage where you can learn new vocabulary, work on a new grammar area, or focus on pronunciation.
- ✓ At the end of each module, you can revise the covered material through a revision test which helps you reflect on your progress and identify the areas you need to work on in the future.

#### Lesson outcomes:

**Lesson 1**: I can start a conversation and use questions in Past Simple to interview my classmates about their weekend.

**Lesson 2:** I can use shopping phrases and do a role play between a shopper and shop assistant at a grocery shop.

**Lesson 3**: I can use adjectives to describe various objects in a shop. I can ask a shop assistant to help me choose a gift.

**Lesson 4**: I can use names of jobs and talk about the jobs I like to do. I can use subject and object questions to interview my classmates about their jobs.

**Lesson 5:** I can use adjectives to describe different jobs. I can discuss positive and negative sides of various jobs and vote for the best job.

**Lesson 6:** I can use adjectives and prepositions of place to describe my office. I can use relevant vocabulary and make questions to role play a dialogue between a real estate agent and a customer.

**Lesson 7:** I can talk about different clothes items and use adjectives to describe them. I can use modals of permission and obligation to talk about dress code at work.

**Lesson 8:** I can talk about different film genres and describe each using positive and negative adjectives. I can interview my classmates about their favourite film.

**Lesson 9**: I can use the Internet related vocabulary and describe my online activities. I can use adverbs of frequency and interview my classmates about their online habits.

**Lesson 10:** I can use transport collocations and talk about travelling. I can talk about different countries and nationalities. I can plan a world- round trip using some expressions for suggestions.

**Lesson 11**: I can use comparative and superlative adjectives to compare different modes of transport and suggest the best ways to travel around my country.

**Lesson 12**: Module test and counselling. I can reflect on my progress in this module. I can ask the teacher questions about what I should do next.
